The District is very proud of our staff for their dedication, skill, and ability to modify and alter their schedules to ensure proper treatment of our Town's wastewater during these times.

The lowest bidder on the project was Apex Construction of Somersworth, NH at \$6.36M. The District was very satisfied with the number as our engineer's estimate was \$6.8M. Construction should begin in September with an anticipated completion date of July of 2022.
